Interesting Saint Lô wardrobe called "wedding" with 2 doors and 3 shelves with drawers inside19th century period The lower plinth is carved with a bouquet of flowers in the center and foliage scrolls on the sidesThe bottom of the doors has 1 large molded panel and is carved with flowers and leavesThe top of the doors is carved with acanthus leaves and a bouquet of flowers in a basketThe upper plinth is also carved with a basket of flowers with foliage scrollsThe cornice is carved with oves and rudenté filletsThe interior consists of 3 shelves including 1 with drawersThis wardrobe is made of solid oak, including the dados and shelvesThe doors are supported by 3 solid brass hingesThe 2 large central brass pins end with dolphinsOriginal lock and keyFully pegged furniture that can be
