The pediments from Aegina are two sculptural groups that decorated the temple of Aphaea, on the island of Aegina, in Attica. Made of Parian marble, they are among the masterpieces of archaic Greek sculpture, away from the austere style, and are both preserved in the Munich Glyptothek. The dying warrior is the most interesting subject.
