Description

Jonathan SELIGER (1955), lacquered bronze sculpture "Gucci" braided metal rope, signed and numbered under the base, A 72 x 91 x 31 cm (some scratches) Jonathan Seliger makes meticulous reproductions/interpretations of mass-produced everyday consumer objects and containers. Departing here from his signature painted canvas constructions to explore fabrications in aluminum, bronze, and stainless steel, sprayed with automotive enamels, he takes the once-popular slogan "Super Size It" to the extreme by presenting larger-than-life versions of a milk carton and a Gucci bag, both over 2.40 m tall, as well as an unfolded Chinese takeout wall box. Seliger draws his visual vocabulary from precedents in contemporary and 20th-century art history, combining notions of scale, seriality, and
