After studying painting at the Yangon University of Culture in 2002, Aung Ko became interested in the complex yet natural evolution of materials, transformed, used, reused, reinvested and reorganized, which often come together in unique projects. The nature of time, the instability of the political climate, and periods of gestation are all central themes that support the singular temporality of each of his creations. His works have been exhibited at the Singapore Biennale in 2008, the 4th Fukuoka Asian Art Triennale (Japan) in 2009, the Onomichi Municipal Museum (Japan) in 2014-2015, the Palais de Tokyo (France) in 2015, and the Institute of
