This set is distinguished by the quality of its work in repoussé and applied silver, demonstrating exceptional expertise. The jardinière features an openwork belt richly decorated with garlands, coat-of-arms medallions and applied female figures (caryatids), inspired by the Louis XVI style. The finely chiseled side handles display a stylized plant decoration. It rests on elegantly sculpted claw feet. The interior bowl is in nickel silver, in perfect condition, without any alteration. The oval-shaped centrepiece is topped with a

beveled mirror, framed by a finely chiseled solid silver border with scrolls and floral motifs. Some mercury alterations are to be noted on the edges of the mirror, testifying to its antiquity without detracting from its elegance. Characteristics: Origin: Hanau (Germany).
