These Mahogany and mahogany veneer armchairs from the Restoration period (1815 - 1830) are interesting for their historical value and their craftsmanship which reflect the aesthetics of their time. They will seduce by their dimension, in particular the height of the seat. The crooked armrests rest on generously cut scrolled consoles, which connect to the seat. The curved upper backrest. They rest on a front "frog leg" base and a rear saber base. The front belt is slightly curved. The upholstery is correct, embossed velvet fabrics to refresh but can be used in the current state. Note trace of restoration at the start of an armrest. Shipping on estimate for France and Internationally. Seat height 42 cm - Total height 95 cm - Width 63 cm - Depth 52 cm.
