Description

Gilt bronze and white marble garniture in the Louis XVI style, 19th century. It consists of two pedestal bowls and a clock. The former are identical: on four circular feet, a polygonal base on which rests a low fluted column decorated with two rows of pearls in its lower part; above, a tall stemmed bowl decorated with two handles in the form of plant stems. The clock rests on four feet, a semicircular base with a floral frieze, four columns and another semicircular plate; highlighted by two branches with joined flowers, it has a white dial and Arabic numerals, as well as Louis XVI-type hands and is surmounted by a vase. The clock's pendulum, in the shape of a sun, is visible between the columns and the decorative chains. The French style known as Louis XVI is characterized by its classical inspiration and
