Description

Beautiful screenprint signed lower right in graphite in the proof. 1971 Gerlinde Beck studied at the Academy of Fine Arts in Stuttgart with Karl Hils, Peter Otto Heim, Gerhard Gollwitzer and Willi Baumeister and also completed an apprenticeship in sheet metal work. Beck made a name for herself through numerous state commissions. Her work was widely exhibited and can still be seen in various museums. She became known to a wide audience with the "Sound Street" created between 1973 and 1984, a series of twelve individual sculptures made of different materials that produce sounds. The artist coined the term spatial choreography to describe her spatially integrated sculptures and installations. Gerlinde Beck was a member of the Deutscher Künstlerbund and GEDOK. In 1996 she founded
