Description

THE TOWN & HARBOUR OF ROCHELLE - Capital of the Province of Aunis, in the Kingdom of France - (Charente Maritime - 17) Etching and burin on laid paper, hand-enhanced with watercolor. Engraved by TOOKEY in the 18th century - English School. This engraving depicts a lively view of the port of LA ROCHELLE, the historic capital of Aunis, in the Kingdom of France. In the foreground, a scene of port life with elegantly dressed figures, sailors, merchants and strollers evokes the intense economic activity of the town. In the background, the famous fortified port is recognizable by its emblematic towers (Tour de la Chaîne, Tour Saint-Nicolas, Tour de la Lanterne) and the forest of merchant ship masts. A large three-masted ship occupies the center of the composition, evoking the
