piece. Functionally, the desk offers practicality with its three drawers on each side and two large carved pedestals, which house cupboards with hidden interior oak-lined drawers. This thoughtful design ensures ample storage space, perfect for organizing papers and office essentials. The pull-out reading slopes, also inset with black tooled leather, add an extra layer of convenience, making it ideal for multitasking. Each of the 12 drawers is fitted with turned oak inset handles, maintaining a cohesive and elegant look. The pedestals rest on a plinth base with turned bun feet, allowing for easier movement while preserving the desk's stability. In terms of condition, the desk is in excellent original state, boasting a rich patina on both the oak and leather, which speaks to its quality craftsmanship and the care it has received over the years. The fact that it comes apart into three pieces adds practicality for moving and setting it up in different spaces.
