"Calèche"?This name is a direct reference to the

famous Calèche perfume, launched by Hermès in

1961, one of the great classics of the House. The

brooch represents miniature bottles of this

perfume, and each one bears the inscription

"Calèche", in homage to this legendary fragrance.

The name Calèche evokes the equestrian and

luxurious world of Hermès (the calèche being an

elegant horse-drawn carriage), a symbol of

French refinement and the heritage of the House,

originally founded as a saddler. Thus, this brooch

is not only a piece of jewelry but also a nod to the

history of Hermès and one of its most emblematic

perfumes.
