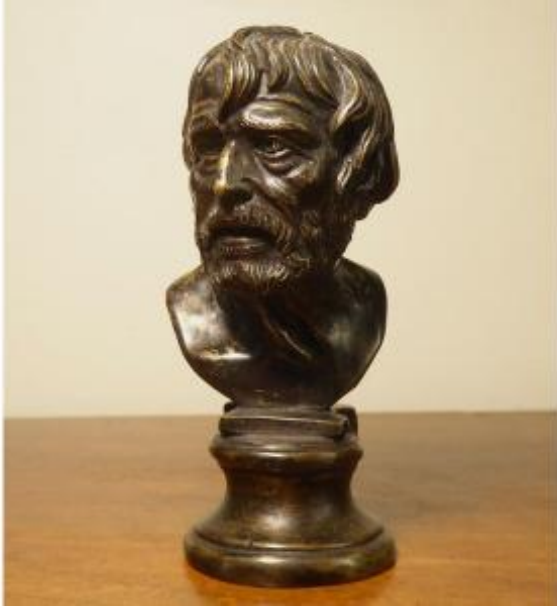




Bronze Bust Of Seneca, Italy, 19th Century
