Empire Mantel Clock "The Warrior with the Torch" - signed Thomire & Cie, circa 1815Dimensions: 30 x 46 x 11 cm (W x H x D)Rare Empire period mantel clock in finely chased and mercury-gilt bronze, depicting a dynamic equestrian figure of a classical warrior triumphantly brandishing a torch. The sculptural composition is executed with great mastery, highlighting the details of the horse's drapery, anatomy and movement. The rectangular base is adorned with a relief frieze of military trophies, helmets and classical motifs, embodying the martial aesthetic of the Napoleonic era. The white enamel dial is delicately signed Thomire & Cie, in reference to Pierre-Philippe Thomire, the most renowned bronzier of the early 19th century and official purveyor to the imperial court.
