Adriaen Pietersz. van de Venne Dutch painter Delft 1589 - 1662 The Hague It is all about the profit ("Om de winst te doen" inscribed on the banner) Oil on panel: 32.6 X 26.2 cm Unsigned Frame: 44.4 X 37.8 cm With certificate from Drs. Luuk Pijl, 16/12/19. Provenance: unsold at the Dorotheum Vienna, 9/06/20, estimate 20,000/30,000. Adriaen van de Venne was a keen observer, painter, book illustrator and poet with a keen sense of humor. After settling in The Hague in 1625, he specialized in these humorous genre scenes. He called his art "Sinne-cunst", meaning "the art of wit". The text in the banderole can be translated as "it's all about profit": an odd couple of street vendors carry too many goods to get to the market. All my paintings stand fully documented
