Description

This Tulip armchair (model F545) is a classic mid-century design by Pierre Paulin, produced by the Dutch manufacturer Artifort in the late 1960s to 1970s. Known for its soft, sculptural form, this chair is one of Paulin's most iconic creations, combining bold shapes with exceptional comfort. The chair has an organic, flower-like shape that wraps around the body, offering great support. It comes in a rare version with grey suedine upholstery, soft to the touch and visually elegant. The base is made of polished chromed metal with a round shape that adds to the sleek, modern look. This set includes a floating headrest and a matching ottoman, both designed to provide full relaxation while keeping the overall design balanced and fluid.
