STONE GARDEN TABLE17th CenturyTable on 4 solid legs with ogee and fillet moldingFrost-resistant limestone from Chatillonnais (Côte d'Or) Top 130 cm x 130 cmThickness 8 cmHeight: 78 cm4 legs with a section of 30 cm x 30 cmThe 4 legs can be joined together in the center of the top to form a single central leg measuring 60 cm x 60 cmOr, if desired, they can be positioned at the 4 corners of the top with a slight offset of 6/8 cm (like the thickness of the top) to create a less monolithic ensemble. This is a choice and can be varied depending on the perspective and the intended location. This set can be placed on a concrete slab buried flush with the ground, or placed on a square of exposed old Burgundy paving just above the installation surface. In this case, a
