He produced still lifes and landscapes. In a late line of symbolism and surrealism, a whole part of his work bears the imprint of his spiritual preoccupations, materialized by the obsessive recurrence of unusual settings and objects such as checkerboard tiles, masks, mannequins and mirrorsVisible at
