KNIFE called Sgian DubhScotlandEarly 20th centurySteel, silver, wood, leather, glassTotal length: 17.1 ; Blade length: 8.6 cmStraight, single-edged steel blade with groove, marked 'STAINLESS STEEL'.Hallmarked silver ferrule.Blackened wood spindle carved in a grid pattern.Pommel with oval orange glass cabochon, openwork silver cap.Wooden scabbard sheathed in black leather.Hallmarked silver cap and bolt.In Scottish Gaelic, the term 'sgian dubh' means 'little knife'.
