KNIFE called Sgian Dubh Scotland Early 20th century Steel, silver, wood, leather, glass Total length: 18 ; Blade length: 9.3 cm Straight, single-edged steel blade with groove. Silver-plated steel ferrule chased with foliage. Blackened wood spindle carved with geometric braiding. Pommel with oval orange glass cabochon, silver-plated steel cap. Black and green leather scabbard decorated with a thistle in an oval with the words 'HONI SOIT QUI MAL Y PENSE'. In Scottish Gaelic, the term 'sgian dubh' means 'little knife'.
