Pair of 22-carat yellow gold earrings from Maison Lalaounis. Greek work, bearing the hallmark of a master goldsmith. Design in superimposed domes, typical of the antique inspiration dear to the house. Clip system. Weight: 20.7g Did you know? Maison Ilias Lalaounis, founded in Athens in 1969, is famous for its jewelry inspired by ancient civilizations, notably Mycenaean and Byzantine Greece. Combining high-grade gold and traditional know-how, Lalaounis has restored the nobility of Hellenic goldsmithing. He was one of the few jewelers to be recognized by the Academy of Fine Arts of the Institut de France, and in 1994 founded in Athens the only museum in the world dedicated to the art of jewelry designed by a living designer.
