



Enameled Sterling Silver Cup, Italian Shooting Prize, Early 20th Century. Art Nouveau.



Description

Magnificent little cup with superb, highly detailed enamel decoration. The cup rests on a flat base, with a more flared rim.It is made of plain silver with, on one side, a very fine and detailed enamel decoration. It features the logo of the "Italian Target Shooting Union" with a rifle, a target, a large lily-of-the-valley branch, and a phylactery inscribed "Italian Target Shooting Union // Federal Army 1922."Such enamel decoration, of such precision and richness, is rare on this type of object awarded during a sporting competition. It is absolutely charming. The interior is light silver gilt. The bottom of the cup is hallmarked: 900 for the fineness. AG within a rectangle, probably the silversmith's mark. Lion within a rectangle, possibly the lion passant of English silver. These last two hallmarks, characteristic of English
