Minerva Hallmarks 1st Title 950 thousandths Each piece numbered ZM attributed to the Zyloric family Weight: 794 grSon and grandson of Parisian goldsmiths established since 1847 rue du Temple, Alphonse Debain had his punch insculcated in 1883 and settled at 79 rue du Temple where he succeeded Philippe Berthier, specialized in small table goldsmithing and religious goldsmithing.
