SABRE OF OFFICER OF THE ROYAL GUARD OF THE REGIMENT OF LANCERS, SIGNED DUKE, Restoration, (1816-1825) hunter's sabre. Weapon mounted in iron, beautiful curved blade with round back, fine fuller, two hollow sides engraved on one side with letters and in a fleur-de-lis cartouche and decorated with a crowned shield with the great arms of France "GARDE ROYALE" on the obverse. We read in the same cartouche "REGI T DE LANCERS". Remains of gilding with ground gold, marking with ricasso and disappearing under the earring on one side "Manufacture royale du Klingenthal Coulaux Frères" and on the other side also disappearing under the earring in shuttle "DUC fourbisseur rue Saint Honoré opposite that richelieu number 281 in Paris.
