



Louis XV Period Console In Gilded Wood



Description

Small console table in carved and gilded wood, resting on two arched console legs, with motifs of foliated and openwork curves and counter-curves. The two legs are joined by a crosspiece carved with an openwork rocaille shell. The belt, also openwork, has a decoration of rocailles and acanthus in a sinuous shape. It is topped with a very beautiful (later) yellow marble veined with red and gray. Work from the Louis XV period. Some wear and restorations to the gilding. Length: 70 cm. Height: 85.5 cm. Depth: 35.5 cm.
