Description

Oil on canvas. 22 x 35 cm. Signed lower right.
With frame. This painting by Jean Bain depicts a subtle twilight landscape, characteristic of the Lyon school to which the artist belonged. Bathed in the fading light of evening, the scene highlights a tranquil stretch of nature where a house, partially hidden by tall trees, emerges in the background, while the sky glows with pink and bluish hues. The artist masterfully contrasts the dense shadow of the foreground with the luminous sky, emphasizing the transition from day to night. In the distance, a few faint human and animal silhouettes add to the serene and contemplative mood. The composition emphasizes the horizontality of the landscape, leading the viewer's eye toward the horizon, where the setting sun's light gently reflects in a
