Pair of pheasants in 835 thousandths solid silver, Belgium, early 20th century Superb pair of pheasants in 835 thousandths solid silver, Belgian work from the early 20th century. These two finely chiseled birds feature a finely engraved decoration, meticulously reproducing the feathers and anatomical details of each bird. The large male pheasant measures 36 cm in total length, while the smaller female measures 27 cm. The whole is in perfect condition, with a total weight of 615 grams, highlighting the quality of the solid silver used. The birds rest on finely sculpted, lightly gilded legs, adding an extra touch of elegance. The quality of the engraving work, particularly visible on the wings and tail of the birds, testifies to the exceptional know-how of the Belgian goldsmiths of this period. Their perfectly

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balanced presentation makes them ideal pieces to adorn a large reception table, especially during a dinner around game.
