Solid silver Art Nouveau vase by the silversmith Roussel, Paris Elegant solid silver vase, from the Art Nouveau period, made by the silversmith Roussel in Paris. This vase has a slender and harmonious form, typical of the Art Nouveau style, with a naturalistic decoration in high relief representing stylized flowers in full bloom, with delicately engraved petals and sinuous stems that perfectly match the curves of the vase. The finely chiseled decoration highlights the organic and vegetal aesthetic specific to this artistic period. The floral motifs stand out with a remarkable relief effect, creating a subtle play of light on the polished surface of the silver. The slightly flared neck emphasizes the graceful silhouette of the piece. The perfectly legible Roussel maker's mark guarantees the authenticity of the work, while the
