## Description

Limestone sculpture from the Romanesque period, 9th century. Represents on one side the martyrdom of Saint Sebastian, his hands tied behind his back ready to receive the arrows that will pierce him. On the other side, the Virgin Mary in prayer represented with her hands joined. French work, Burgundy, 9th-10th century. Erosions of the stone. Rests on a carved wooden base. Height: 33 cm - Length: 19 cm - Width 15 cm. Comes from a castle in Burgundy. Customs taxes are included in the delivery for international shipments. The packaging will be very carefully made to measure and reinforced with insurance.
