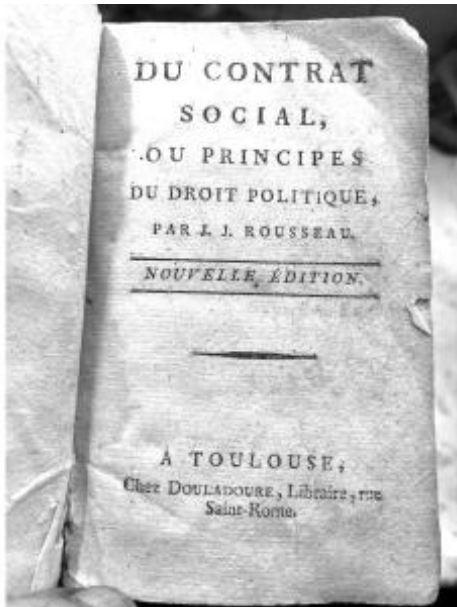

"The Social Contract" is a work of political philosophy by Jean-Jacques Rousseau published in 1762 for the first time. The central idea of the work is that the Citizens of a State must unite to protect themselves and ensure their Liberty. The Social Contract, the bonds uniting Citizens among themselves, does not therefore obey a natural Law, but is a convention, which all must respect so that Society can function. The
