Henri Picou. Charcoal drawing on paper "maternal embrace" signed lower right Henri Picou. French school. 20.6 X 15 cm at sight. 38.5 X 32.3 overall. Henri Jean Picou was born in Nantes (Loire-Atlantique) in 1784 and died in the same city in 1865. He was the father of Eugène and Henri Pierre. He was a student of Jacques-Louis David (1748-1825). Nantes Cathedral has his "Creation of the Order of the Sisters of Saint Vincent de Paul". Sources: Bénézit dictionary of painters and sculptors. The quality of our drawing demonstrates how the teaching of the great master David, combined with the talent of a young Picou, can generate an ethereal and delicate work.
