Kuindzhi. In 1895 he received the title of class artist of the 3rd degree, and in 1897 - the title of artist. In 1900 his personal exhibition took place in St. Petersburg, and in 1901 he presented his works in Munich. Since 1910 he was a member of the Kuindzhi Society. Lived in St. Petersburg (Leningrad). He died in 1942 during the siege of Leningrad. Kalmoukov mainly painted landscapes with a marine theme and often visited Crimea. His brushes include works such as "Moonlit Night in Kikeneiz", "Foggy Morning", "Surf at the Iron Cliffs" and "Twilight". In the 1930s, he painted several paintings for the Arctic and Antarctic Museum and the Leningrad Mining Institute Museum. Kalmykov's works have been exhibited in the Tretyakov Gallery, the State Russian Museum and exhibited at auction.
