This carpet is clean, the wool is soft, beautifully knotted and finely tight as these wonders always are. It reveals to us nuances full of contrasts, very many colors. Large ramages placed on a deep red field. It is surrounded by a border of bouquets, lotus flowers, stylized peony flowers. Traditional wool carpet, comfortable and of great passage. The nuances underline this learned floral design in the great tradition of Persian art that we also find in Mughal art, inspired by the miniatures of the school of Tabriz, then capital of the Persian empire, but completely revised in the middle of the 20th century.
