Description

Romantic painting of a group of travelers in a fictional Italianate landscape, by an anonymous master. This work, which probably dates from the first half of the 19th century, is a typical example of Romantic landscape art. Romanticism manifested itself primarily in the arts (literature, music, and visual arts) and in intellectual circles, opposing the ideals of the Enlightenment. The Romantics sought to return to pristine, unspoiled nature, which is perfectly reflected in this work. In painting, Romanticism spanned a period of more than 50 years. In terms of periodization, the period from 1790 to 1850 is generally considered, although several late Romantic works from the second half of the 19th century are known. Romantic landscapes often combine fantasy and reality. The style is characterized by a strong
