Description

Elegant French table in Louis XVI style, crafted in the second half of the 19th century. The structure is made of finely carved wood and enriched with gold leaf gilding (zecchino), which enhances the refinement of its shapes and decorative details. The four fluted legs, typical of neoclassical taste, are connected by a crossed stretcher ending in a central floral urn motif, offering both balance and visual lightness. The current top is in onyx, with beautiful veining and rich color variations, though it likely originally featured a white marble top, more in keeping with the essential lines of the Louis XVI style. With its harmonious proportions (72 x 53 cm, height 80 cm), the piece is ideal as a centerpiece or side table in elegant, sophisticated interiors. In good condition, this piece combines decorative charm
