Crafted from laminated timber and keyaki veneer, this coffee table stands out with its curved, organic design. The thick, meticulously crafted tabletop is enhanced by a subtle interplay of wood grain, while the gently curved legs extend the fluidity of the form, creating a piece that is both elegant and functional. The soft lines and refined finish of this table make it a harmonious addition to any contemporary interior. The vintage Tendo Mokko logo is affixed to the underside of the tabletop.
