After working under Junzo Sakakura at the Institute of Architecture, he founded his own studio in 1972. This teak plywood table is emblematic of Tendo Mokko's innovation, renowned for its mastery of molded plywood. The curved legs add a touch of elegance that will fit perfectly into any interior.
