This iconic vase by Shiro Kuramata perfectly illustrates his unique approach to design, blending minimalism with playful creativity. This bud vase is composed of a pink anodized aluminum tube that is encased in a parallelepiped structure of transparent acrylic resin, emphasizing its elegance and lightness.
