Decorative mushroom carved by Robert Haussmann for a boutique in Zurich in the 1970s. Swiss architect and designer Robert Haussmann is a major figure in post-war European design, renowned for his experimental approach and his offbeat take on aesthetics. Hand-carved, this wooden mushroom displays a raw and expressive texture, the result of gouging.
