Description

Circular hard porcelain plate with a scalloped edge. White background decorated with a central circular medallion, surrounded by a thin gold border, adorned in sepia monochrome with a lively rustic interior scene: two men playing cards, while a woman sits near a fireplace, in a room furnished with sobriety (fireplace, staircase, chairs). This scene evokes genre engravings or intimate compositions inspired by the Dutch masters of the 17th century. The medallion is encircled by a fine garland of golden bindweed. The rim, with a pale pink background, is divided into alternating compartments, mixing: geometric diamond patterns, some in trompe-l'oeil in marquetry or star style, polychrome rocaille arabesques enhanced with gold borders, punctuated by small patterns suspended in the
