Rare advertising lithograph on cardboard, created in 1904 by the renowned Catalan artist Gaspar CAMPS Y JUNYENT (1864-1942). He was an iconic figure of the Art Nouveau movement. This advertisement was designed for the Champagne House ROEDERER, founded in 1864 by Théophile ROEDERER, which went on to become one of the most prestigious houses in the Reims region. It is printed on cardboard and bears the original framer's label on the back. Original bleached wooden frame. Very beautiful and vivid colors, with two small marks noted on the left side and lower right corner. It does not have a glass pane. It is in its original condition--stunning, decorative, and spectacular--more than 120 years after its creation.A very uncommon piece for collectors of Art Nouveau, the Belle Époque, and
