



Rene Princeteau : "the Return From The Fields"



Description

René Princeteau (1843-1914) : "The Return from the Fields", oil on canvas 114 X 146 cm. Relined and old restorations, bears a label with the number 17 at the bottom right. A friend of Lautrec who was also his student, Grand Master of equine representations, he left us numerous paintings both on hunting with hounds and on rural life which at the time mainly used animal traction for field work. Our scene is linked to this second group with the young peasant woman riding bareback who brings her horses back to the farm at nightfall. The touch, in a very spirited sketch and reworked with the handle of the brush in the fresh material, is extremely suggestive and teeming with details: the light crescent moon beginning to emerge, the happy smile of the rider, or the foal which, after stopping to graze on an
