Description

Oil painting on wood signed top left Léon Brunin + Certificate of Authenticity from the Hand of Léon Brunin on the back (see photo). Measuring 39.5cm x 24.5cm without frame, 57cm x 43cm in total. Representing a Landscape painted around 1885. Léon Brunin (pseudonym of Léon Demeuter), 1861-1949, Belgian painter of genre, portraits, figures and animated landscapes. A student of Frans Joris, he began sculpture at the Academy of Fine Arts in Antwerp. He abandoned sculpture for painting under the direction of Polydore Beaufaux, then Charles Verlat. He began in 1880, in 1886, he became a professor at the Academy of Antwerp. He mainly painted Flemish interiors in the style of Rembrandt and animated landscapes. Works in the Museums of Antwerp, Chicago and Munich. Artist listed at
