Square table by Saburo Inui, created in the 1960s for Tendo Mokko. Saburo Inui, an engineer and master of Japanese design, played a key role in the evolution of Tendo Mokko, particularly in its innovative use of bentwood. As technical director, he helped establish the company's reputation for designs that blended traditional craftsmanship with modernity. This table is distinguished by its rounded-edge tabletop and fluid design, where the elegant curves of the top flow seamlessly into the legs. Designed with respect for Japanese aesthetics, it combines a clean form with a perfect balance of functionality and beauty. The teak wood used for this table adds a rich texture. Originally designed as a dining table for a traditional Japanese interior, its timeless and refined silhouette now makes it a
