Louis XV style coffee table signed Grimard à Paris - Floral marquetry, Aleppo breccia marble and gilded bronzes - Napoleon III period Elegant Louis XV style coffee table, in precious wood marquetry and richly decorated with gilded bronzes, resting on four curved legs with foliate falls and finely chiseled sabots. It is signed "Grimard à Paris" on the edge of the drawer, a rare and highly sought-after signature on the 19th century decorative arts market. The Aleppo breccia marble top, in warm shades of wine red and ochre, is encircled by an openwork gilded bronze gallery. The apron is inlaid with a delicate floral decoration inlaid on a herringbone frieze background, while the lower shelf, curved like the top, features a three-dimensional checkerboard marquetry.
