Description

Titled Charles IX duelist by its creator Emmanuel Frémiet in 1879, this noble figure holds a sword against his chest and appears to be waiting for a confrontation with a belligerent expression. Gilt bronze statuette produced in the first part of the 20th century (1910/1920) by the Barbedienne foundry in Paris. Perfect condition (probably missing spurs), original gilding, sea green worked marble base, bronze counter base. Signature E Frémiet and foundry stamp. The height indicated includes the base. Emmanuel Frémiet (1824/1910) is one of the most famous sculptors of the second half of the 19th century, addressing many subjects: historical figures, animal subjects or religious themes, among his most famous works: Joan of Arc in the Place des Pyramides, Louis d'Orléans in the courtyard of the Château
