Superb pocket watch display, one of those fine thick watches, which were called "onion" under French Regence and Louis XV. Placed in the evening near bed, it served as a bedside clock. It is a lacework of rocaille sculpture, from resinous wood, a knotless pine, period color and gilding. The patient Chronos, Greek demi-God personifying time, bearded, sitting on a mound, leaning on his large hourglass, counts the time we have left... ... Alpine work, Austria, Italy, Tyrol, from 18th century. Good condition, all original, (except a screw of base), I only removed a troublesome varnish, polished and waxed. gilding is still beautiful. 29cm x 15cm x 7.5cm. Look carefully at our photos.
