Description

Pair of armchairs with a sculptural and assertive design by Maison Jansen, made around 1970, in a neo-classical modernist style emblematic of the famous Parisian house. Structure in curved chromed metal forming a fluid and balanced X-bed, topped with curved arms and uprights decorated with stylized tips. Adjustable and 360-degree adjustable feet. The seat and backrest are stretched with wide patinated leather straps, fixed by a refined lateral lacing, providing comfort and flexibility. With this Savonarola model inspired by the curial seats of Roman antiquity, Maison Jansen combines here historical references and contemporary design with great mastery. Combining classical eclecticism and decorative rigor, at the service of the most prestigious interiors of the 20th century.
