Igor Mitoraj (1944-2014), a French-Polish sculptor of global acclaim, studied at the Academy of Fine Arts in Kraków and later in Paris. Today, he is considered one of the most influential sculptors of the late 20th century. His monumental works are installed in iconic locations such as Piazza dei Miracoli in Pisa, Kraków's flower market, Versailles gardens, and La Défense in Paris. His unique blend of classical form and modern symbolism has left an indelible mark on contemporary sculpture.
