Lovely watercolor by the English painter David COX Sr (1783-1859) who depicted Stirling Castle in Scotland (see last photos for comparison), standing on top of a hill, with a few figures animating the composition.David COX is considered one of the greatest English landscape painters, and a major figure in the golden age of English watercolor.
