Upper scene: This composition shows a group of figures within a domestic setting. A woman in yellow clothing appears to be arguing with another seated, while other figures react with surprise or try to intervene. The atmosphere is excited and theatrical, with sweeping and dramatic gestures.2. Lower scene:In this second print, the action intensifies further: three women are involved in a violent argument, with one of them brandishing an object above her head ready
